Art's Day at Pascali

The 26th of May Our Headmistress, Professor **Irma D'Ambrosio** and the students organised the **Art's Day**. Main topics were the **Dada** (celebrating the 100th yrs. of its birth) and the **Digital identity**. The event involved over 400 students showing their works, dance, installations, music venue and so on.



FAI Spring Days 2016

In March **FAI** (Fondo Ambiente Italiano) has celebrated its Spring Days, a great opportunity to discover and visit free more than 700 places throughout Italy. The historical place opened in Bari was the **Theatre Niccolò Piccinni**; our students were volunteers who gave guided tours to all the visitors.



Voices and Bodies

The 31st of May the school organized a show at **Theatre Abeliano**. The show had several parts: Theatre, Classical and Contemporary Dance. **Yerma** is the second of the three tragedies of F.García Lorca. All the students involved had great commitment and fun. It's a great "monologue" in which the protagonist lives his drama of young bride doomed to sterility. **The Special Comedy** Inspired by Dante's Divine Comedy and coordinated by **Tiziana A. Piscitelli**, it's the result of a workshop of creative writing that involved teachers, students and disabled students. The scene was a set made of 15 cubes of



corrugated paper. The show was translated simultaneously in LIS - Language Italian Sign and won the First Prize as best didactic project in the School Contest **"Skenè"**. **Class Concert, Arabesque and Double Act** were dance performances on musics of Sostakovic, Benstead, Sakamoto e Ianne, coordinated by **Anna Marinelli e Simona Fiorentino**. All students were engaged in a very hard task achieving a significant result.
